MISCELLANY

कोध

भारतीय धर्मग्रंथों में काम, क्रोध, मद और लोभ को नरक का रास्ता बताया गया है। इनमें से एक नरक के द्वार 'क्रोध' के विषय में अपने विचार रखना चाहूँगी।

इस खानदान की नकचढ़ी बहू है	– ईर्ष्या
पोती है	– घृणा
मां है	– उपेक्षा

निश्चय ही कोई भी समझदार जीव अचानक अपने आप आ जाने वाले 'कोध' को अपने पास नहीं आने देगा क्योंकि कोध का खानदान तो अनगिनत नरक के रास्तों को आमंत्रित कर देगा। कोध के वैश्विक धरातल पर दिखने वाले रुप से पूरी सभ्यता आतंकित है। अतः इसके छोटे से छोटे रुप को भी आमंत्रित नहीं करना चाहिए।
