e-Learning Management System (e-LMS) of ISTM

- 1. The COVID 19 pandemic resulted in discontinuation of class room training. To meet this challenge, the System Administration Unit in ISTM had taken an initiative to develop an e-Learning Management System (e-LMS) for providing online training. The e-LMS of ISTM is a fully indigenous effort by the ISTM System Administration Unit. The training is being conducted through the ISTM e-LMS and through third party software for conduct online classes.
- 2. ISTM e-LMS is not only equipped to deliver content, but it also handles creating courses, registering & managing participants, sending email & SMS, obtaining feedback during the training period and at the end of training, etc. The ISTM e-LMS enables the participants to attend the training programmes, anywhere and at any time.
- 3. e-LMS of ISTM has the following features for course management: -

Online Registration

As per the eligibility criteria defined in the course circular, Govt. employees from Central / State, PSUs, Autonomous Bodies are able to submit the online nomination form. Course Director concerned is able to shortlists the nominations and send confirmation email & SMS through the e-LMS platform along with the details of the course.

Email & SMS

Course Director can send customized emails & SMSs to the participants.

e-LMS dashboard

On registration and acceptance of nomination, participant is given a unique Application Number. They can access the ISTM e-LMS course through their Application Number. Once they are successfully logged in, they will be routed to the e-LMS dashboard page. In that page, the session plan is displayed along with the topics to be covered during the course would be displayed, day wise. On clicking the specific topic, in the right panel, related resources viz. videos, reading materials, presentations, reference URL, etc. would be displayed. On each page, option is available for sending query to the Course Director concerned / Faculty through the e-LMS platform and the reply will also be displayed in the same platform. Provision for sharing documents (PDF, Word, MP3) along with reply for further clarification is also

Webinar Page

Separate webinar page is designed along with each topic and the faculty details along with webinar links are linked to that page. On clicking the link by the participants, they will be redirected to the webinar session page and can join the session by filling up their name & email, which is mandatory for attendance purposes.

Feedback

Provision has also been made for obtaining feedback from each participants online during the training period (Day Wise / Week Wise) and also at the end of training. The collected feedback will be used for further improvement of the Training Programme. In addition to this, participants can provide suggestions anytime through the SMS made and that will be sent to the Course Director concerned for taking necessary action immediately.

Question Bank

A Question Bank for the topics covered during the Training Programmes can be developed, which can be used for self-assessment and online examination.

- 4. Till now, 8 courses have been completed successfully through ISTM e-LMS platform. Resources on 33 topics are available on e-LMS, which can be used for various upcoming programmes / courses.
- 5. Future plans for ISTM e-LMS are as follows:
 - i) Assignment Module along with evaluation provision
 - ii) Assessment Module with answer sheet for self-assessment
 - iii) Online Certification Module
 - iv) Tracking of Course Participants online

Launch of Cadre Training Programmes on iGOT and eLMS platforms



कड़वी सच्चाई

ऑफिस से आते-जाते मैं रोज़ उस व्यक्ति को देख रही थी, बहुत-सी भगवान की मूर्तियां और फोटो लिए कम्बल ओढ़े पांव फैलाए, बढ़ी हुई सफेद दाढ़ी, सफेद बाल, बस स्टैंड के पास बैठे हुए। एक दिन सोचा कि कुछ पैसे दे देती हूं और उसकी तरफ हाथ बढ़ा कर बोली, 'बाबा, यह ले लो कुछ पैसे'। उसने मुझे देखा और बोला, 'क्या उम्र है आपकी? मुझे बाबा बोल रही हो।' मैं बोली 50 साल, क्यों, क्या हो गया?' मै थोड़ा घबरा गई, मैं बोली, 'कोई गलती हो गई क्या?' वह बोला, 'नहीं माँ, मेरी उम्र सिर्फ 32 साल है।' उसकी बात सुनकर मैं एकदम अचिभित हो गई, शायद झूठ बोल रहा होगा, ऐसा मन मे विचार आया। सोचा कि पैसा देकर कहीं गलती तो नहीं की। वह बोला, 'आपकी तरह मेरी भी माँ है, लेकिन अब नहीं।' जैसे वह अपनी आप बीती बताने के लिए आज आतुर हो गया और बोला, 'माँ-बाप के बढ़ते झगड़े, दादा-दादी का झगड़ा, नाना-नानी का झगड़ा, कुछ समझ में नहीं आता था, लेकिन दस वर्ष का होने पर जब कुछ समझ आया, तब पाया कि माँ ने चुपचाप दूसरा विवाह कर लिया है। वह कई दिन तक नाना नानी के घर रही और उसके दूसरे विवाह कि सूचना घर पर आई। कुछ दिन के बाद पिता ने भी दूसरा विवाह रचा लिया।'

'दादा-दादी रहे नहीं, नाना-नानी ने कभी पूछा ही नहीं कि जिंदा भी हूं कि नहीं। माँ का अपना परिवार, अपना सुख, अपने सुख को पाने के लिए वह अपने पेट के जने पुत्र को बिलकुल ही भूल गई। माँ ने अपना सुख पा लिया और पिता ने अपना। अब रहा मैं, जिन्दगी की जंजीरों में जकड़ा हुआ आपके सामने।

'कहते हैं "पूत कपूत सुने हैं पर न माता सुनी कुमाता" इन सब भगवानों से मैं यही पूछ रहा हूँ कि मैं इतना बूढ़ा दिखने लगा कि पचास, साठ, सत्तर वर्ष के व्यक्ति भी मुझे बाबा कहने लगे। इसमें मेरा क्या कसूर था जबाब मांग रहा हूं इनसे। ना मां का सुख मिला, ना पिता का साया, ना कोई परिवार, पागल भी नही हूं, वक्त का सताया शायद, कुछ समझ नहीं पा रहा हूं।'

'मैं यहां पर बैठा बहुत कुछ अच्छा और उससे भी ज्यादा गलत होते देखता रहता हूँ, पर सब अच्छा या गलत करके अपने-अपने घर चले जाते हैं और मैं फिर भी यहीं पड़ा रहता हूँ। अपने भविष्य को देखने के लिए।'

मेरे पास उसके सवालों का कोई जवाब नहीं था और न ही बातों की कोई काट। उसकी आपबीती सुनकर मेरा मुंह कसैला हो आया था। पैसे देने के लिए जो हाथ मैंने उसकी तरफ बढ़ाया था, उसे चुपचाप अपनी चुनरी के अंदर छिपा लिया था।
